



“Pulling for the North Country” Truck Pull

Terms and Conditions

By participating in the United Way of Northern New York’s (UWNNY) “Pulling for the North Country” truck pull event (two separate occasions, together referred to as the “event”), participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The event is a fundraiser to support the charitable efforts of UWNNY and by participating in the event, entrants acknowledge, understand and agree that their participation in the event is voluntary.

1. **Event Description.** The “Pulling for Northern New York” event is an exclusive United Way of Northern New York fundraiser that celebrates our 100th Anniversary in two locations. The primary activity at each event consists of a truck pull competition where 10-person teams compete for the shortest time to pull a semi-truck tractor and trailer a set distance. Accompanying the competition is a static display area filled with large farm equipment, US Army combat vehicles unique on and off-road vehicles, live music and food for families to enjoy. There are two identical competitive events, where the teams will only compete against other teams that pull at that venue.
 - a. Saturday, September 18, 2021, at SUNY Canton
 - b. Saturday, October 2, 2021, at Watertown Fairgrounds
2. **Sponsor.** The event is sponsored by UWNNY, a New York State non-profit organization. All decisions made by the UWNNY, with respect to the event, are final.
3. **Eligibility.** The event is open to the general public, corporations, businesses, schools and government employees.
4. **Team Composition.** A team participating in the event consists of 10 individuals. There is no limitation to age, gender or weight of the team.
5. **Waiver.** Each team member will sign a waiver prior to the event which holds UWNNY, the venue (SUNY Canton and the City of Watertown at the Fairgrounds) and other vendors/participants harmless. Participants under the age of 18 will require a parent/guardian signature.
6. **Scoring.** Each team will pull a semi-truck (tractor and trailer) a distance of 20 yards for time. The time is then multiplied by the total weight of the team. The lowest composite score wins.

7. **How to Enter.** Event registration is available at <https://www.unitedway-nny.org/truck-pull/> or by visiting UWNKY at 120 Washington Street, Suite 201, Watertown, NY.
8. **Cost.** Team registration is \$500 (\$50 per team member) and is non-refundable.
9. **Event Period.** Two separate events will take place: Saturday, September 18, 2021 at SUNY Canton and Saturday, October 2, 2021 at the Watertown Fairgrounds.
10. **Transferability.** Registration only requires a single point of contact and a team name. Team membership may be changed up until the moment of participation.
11. **Prizes.** Prizes will be awarded to the 3 best scoring teams at each event.
12. **Affidavit of Eligibility.** The 3 best scoring teams will sign an affidavit of eligibility, attesting to the team members eligibility, compliance with the terms, and permission for UWNKY to use the 3 best scoring team's names, place of residence, voice, and likeness in media releases and other publicity.
13. **Notification.** The 3 best scoring teams shall be notified by telephone and/or email. The 3 best scoring teams do not need to be present at the end of the event to win.
14. **Amendments.** UWNKY reserves the right to amend the terms, conditions, and procedures of the event at any time.
15. **Release of Liability.** Teams and team members release UWNKY and its directors, officers, members and agents from any and all liability, loss or claim arising out of event prize, and expressly waive any such claim and agree that the liability, if any, of UWNKY and its directors, officers, members and agents shall be limited to the price of the event registration.
16. **Governing Law and Venue.** Terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. Any disputes relating to the event must be held in courts of competent jurisdiction in St. Lawrence County (SUNY Canton event) or Jefferson County (Watertown Fairgrounds event).
